



Code of Conduct and General Guidelines

Mobile Phones

No Delegate, member of the Media, IP, Crisis staff or Logistics team is allowed to carry a mobile phone. Any mobile phone brought will be confiscated and will not be returned for at least three months.

Internet and Other Electronic Devices

Delegates and IP members are allowed to carry laptops only. IPads, tablets and internet dongles are not allowed. Delegates will not have access to the Internet during the conference. They will be provided the same only at the discretion of the Bureau. Therefore, all delegates are required to keep everything that they might need during the conference downloaded on their laptops or keep a hard copy of the same. In case a delegate is unable to carry a laptop to school during the conference days, they can carry print outs of all reference material.

Water Bottles

All students attending the Shishukunj MUN are required to get their water bottles to school on the conference days. Please note that to take a step towards sustainable living, no packaged water bottles will be provided. There will be water dispensers located outside of each committee room which can be used by everyone to refill their water bottles.

Transportation

Buses will ply on all routes during the conference days for both arrival and departure. No participants will be allowed to leave the conference in between. Once they arrive, they will only be allowed to depart after the completion of that day's sessions. No change will be allowed in the buses to be used by arrival or departure by any student.

Dress Code and Conference IDs

To maintain and enhance security, all participants of the Shishukunj MUN are required to visibly wear the conference IDs which will be given to them on August 16, 2024 upon their arrival. Everyone has to comply with the dress code at all times during the conference. If anyone's attire is deemed inappropriate by the Secretariat or the school administration, the student will be asked to leave the session and return with appropriate attire.

Photography and Video

Throughout the conference, Shishukunj MUN staff, Media Team and representatives may take photographs, videos and interviews that show the conference participants which may be used for promotional, educational or other purposes for Shishukunj MUN. By attending the conference, participants consent to be photographed, videotaped, and/or interviewed and authorize Shishukunj MUN to use them in any manner of Shishukunj MUN's choosing.

Minimum Attendance

The participants will only be awarded the certificate of participation and be considered for awards only after attending a minimum of 13 hours of committee sessions.

Expulsion from the Conference

The Secretariat reserves the right to expel any Delegate, IP, Media and Logistics member from the conference at any time for violating or failing to comply with conference regulations, or for any other reason. Expulsions shall take effect immediately at the time that they are issued. All conference registration materials (i.e. conference IDs and placards) must be surrendered to the conference staff upon expulsion.
